It strengthens our relationship with the Church and gives us a special strength from the Holy Spirit to defend the faith and confess the name of Christ.

Clothing Guidelines for Confirmation

All Confirmation Candidates will wear their red robes as distributed through Saint Ann over the simple garments listed below.

- All clothing should be simple and modest.
- Shoes should be clean and in good condition. Heel 1.5 inch or lower.
- Dress shirts may be short or long sleeved.
- Dress pants should be solid in a dark color, khaki or white.
- Dresses (not required) must be modest and simple.
- Not Allowed: Denim, visible lettering/words, athletic shoes or clothing, flip-flop or slide footwear

Other Guidelines

- Hair should be neat and worn off the face so that the Bishop may easily anoint each candidate.
- Personal items, including phones, should be turned off and left with family members.
- Any jewelry and accessories should be kept to a minimum.
- Any nail polish on fingers (or toes if they show) should be a pale color or clear.

Suggestions for Sponsors
