Confirmation Covenant

1. We believe that Christians are called to serve God and our neighbors. Confirmation Class of 2020 Candidates (Confirmation II) will complete a minimum of 4 "Service Events" to help prepare them for lives of service. This is in addition to the 2 events completed during Confirmation I (if applicable). 2. Candidates will attend and participate in the Rite of Welcoming at the 11:30 a.m. mass on November 17.
3. Focusing on the sacrament and on building up our faith community, all Confirmation Candidates will participate in our St. Ann Confirmation Retreat on Tuesday, March 24 from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. located in Madonna Hall in the St. Ann Parish Office building.
4. Any candidate unable to attend our retreat on March 24 will need to find and attend another Catholic confirmation retreat, as required by the diocese.
5. Supporting you as your child's first and primary catechists, our diocese requires that at least one parent attend our St. Ann Confirmation Parent Class.
6. Candidates will attend and participate in the Rite of Enrollment during the 11:30 a.m. mass on Sunday, April 26.
7. Growing spiritually on this journey will be greatly supported and invigorated by regular participation in Mass and celebration of Reconciliation. Parents will provide for their candidates to participate in weekly Sunday Mass and will provide for them to celebrate Reconciliation at least once in Advent and again in Lent. Both SAS and PRE will announce dates for Reconciliation.
8. Candidates will exhibit their preparedness through an assessment of relevant learned material, as determined by catechist, based on classroom learning and any other assignments.
9. To properly prepare the candidates, it is required that PRE Confirmation II students participate in their full PRE class as scheduled. Five excused absences are allowed. Our school students are required to adhere to the attendance and participation policies set forth by our school.
10. Reflecting respect and reverence in our appearance as we celebrate Confirmation, candidates agree to abide by the Dress Requirement guidelines set forth.
