Receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation is a sacred and special event in the lives of our young people. Confirmation unites us more firmly to Christ. It strengthens our relationship with the Church and gives us a special strength from the Holy Spirit to defend the faith and confess the name of Christ.

Dress Requirements for Confirmation

All Confirmation Candidates will wear their red robes as ordered through Saint Ann over the simple garments listed below.

Male Candidates:

- Hair should be neatly trimmed, combed and worn off the face so that the Bishop may easily anoint each candidate
- Dress shirts (may be short or long sleeved)
- Neckties are not required
- Dress pants
- No denim clothing
- Shoes should be clean and in good condition
- No athletic shoes, flip flops or slides
- Personal items, including phones, should be left with family members



Female Candidates:

- Hair should be neat and worn off the face so that the Bishop may easily anoint each candidate
- Dresses should be simple and modest, no denim
- Shoes should be clean and in good condition
- Shoe heels must be 1 inch or lower; flats are fine
- No athletic shoes, flip flops or slides
- Any nail polish on fingers (or toes if they show) should be a pale color or clear
- Any jewelry and accessories should be kept to a minimum
- Purses and other personal items, including phones, should be left with family members

Male and Female Sponsors:

Although not required, the same guidelines as above will also serve well for our sponsors.
