## Educational Goals

Through whole group and individualized lessons, Junior and Senior Two year old students will experience reading, math, science, art, music & movement, and religion. Our program is designed to encourage independence and curiosity through play, learning, and friendship.

### Junior Twos

- Age: 15 months by August 15th and walking
- Goals:
- Achieve a comfort level with being away from home
  - Develop fine motor skills by introducing the crayon and paint brush
  - Develop listening skills
  - Demonstrate side by side play
  - Develop gross motor skills through outside play
  - Hold hands together in prayer

### Senior Twos

- Age: 2 years old by August 15th
- Goals:
- Achieve a comfort level with being away from home
  - Follow directions
  - Develop listening skills
  - Achieve potty training
  - Recognize eight basic colors
  - Recognize six basic shapes
  - Recognize numbers 0 -5 and introduce math concepts
  - Develop fine motor skills with coloring, painting, gluing, and puzzles.
  - Develop gross motor skills through outside play
  - Learn sign of the cross and simple prayers

Through small group, whole group, individualized lessons, and cooperative learning, three and four year old students will experience math, science, early literacy, Spanish, art, music & movement, and religion. Our program is designed to encourage independence, curiosity, and build self-esteem through play, learning, and friendship.

### **Threes**

Age: 3 years old by August 15th

Goals: Follow directions such as sit still and wait your turn  
Demonstrate independence in potty  
Demonstrate ability to play and share with others  
Develop fine motor skills through use of crayons, paint brushes, pencil, gluing, scissors, and puzzle assembly  
Develop gross motor skills through outside play  
Recognize name, including first letter  
Recognize and recite numbers 1 through 10  
Recite basic colors in Spanish  
Count to 1 through 10 in Spanish  
Tracing  
Introduce days of the week and months of the year  
Learn sign of the cross and simple prayers

### **Fours**

Age: 4 years old by August 15th

Goals: Develop fine motor skills through use of pencil, crayon, marker, paint brush, gluing, scissors, and puzzle assembly  
Follow multiple directions  
Accept responsibility  
Demonstrate critical thinking  
Develop gross motor skills through outside play  
Learn sign of the cross and simple prayers  
Recite the "Pledge of Allegiance"  
Recite days of the week and months of the year  
Recognize and print name (using correct upper and lower case letters)  
Recite and recognize numbers 0 – 20  
Print numbers 0 - 10  
Recite basic colors in Spanish  
Count to 1 through 10 in Spanish  
Demonstrate the ability to sort, sequence, and graph  
Recognize and write upper and lower case letters and recognize the phonetic sound the letter makes  
Recite birth date, address and phone number  
Recognize size differences and opposites
