LITURGICAL AND PARISH SERVICE ENCOUNTERS

MASS (LITURGICAL) VOLUNTEERS

When the Church comes together in the liturgical assembly to celebrate the Mass, or any other sacrament, her members gather in a variety of ministries and roles. Many of these roles are exercised by lay people who place their time and talent at the service of the liturgical assembly as altar servers, lectors, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, cantors, choir members, instrumentalists, leaders of song and ushers. To aid our candidates in transitioning to active members of the church, these roles are available as service encounters:

- ALTAR SERVER Volunteers will shadow the current altar servers under the direction
 of the Altar Server MC.
- ALTAR SERVER MC (MASTER OF CEREMONIES) Current, trained altar servers will shadow/train for the Altar Server MC position for confirmation service.
- **CHOIR** 5:00 **PM SUNDAYS** Participation at 5:00 pm mass will count as a service encounter for this role. Childrens' choir (school choir) will not count; the goal is to bring our students out of the role as children in the church and into the role of responsible adult participants.
- **JUNIOR SACRISTAN** Volunteers will shadow the sacristan to learn the responsibilities and help as needed during mass.
- **USHER/ST. MEINRAD HOSPITALITY** Volunteers will greet and welcome parishioners, assist ushers during mass and distribute bulletins.
